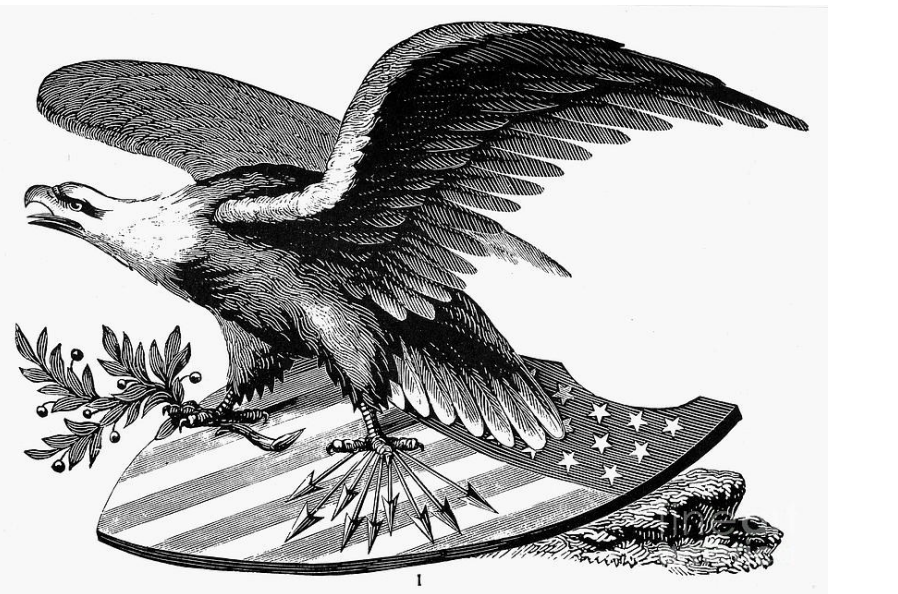


TYPICAL MUSTER ROLL

Official Mustering Out Documents for Company E, 123rd Illinois Infantry Regiment, Captain Zachary H McCubbins, of Granville, Illinois, Company Commander at time of discharge. Colonel Jonathan Biggs, commanding the 123rd Infantry.



MUSTER-OUT ROLL of Captain Zach H. McCubbins, Company [E], in the 123 Regiment of Illinois Infantry Volunteers, commanded by Colonel Jonathan Biggs, called into the service of the United States by the President U. S., at Mattoon, Illinois, (the place of general rendezvous,) on the day of September, 1862, to serve for the term of three years, from the date of enrollment, unless sooner discharged; from the day of 186, (when) to the day of 186. The Company was organized by Captain Zach H. McCubbins, at Mattoon, Ill. in the month of August, 1862, and marched thence to Mattoon, Illinois where it arrived the fourteenth of August, a distance of forty miles.
