

Many families contributed multiple men to the Union Army, but none provided as many family members as the Hart family. The Hart family was one of the early families to settle in and around Mattoon. Many of the Harts lived on farms scattered all over the area southwest of Mattoon. Altogether, fourteen Hart men enlisted in various regiments.
